Dear Denver Campus Students and Faculty;

I hope Spring 2021 is off to a good start. The last couple of weeks have been a bit bumpy, with getting folks into the building on campus, and the jolt of registration for Summer 2021 happening so early in the quarter. Here is some “tune-up” information to ensure you have the resources you need moving forward.

Please remember you still have time to add and drop courses for the summer, or to meet with your advisors. Please double check that you have registered for field for spring or summer if applicable for you. If you are **registering for BLOCK field:**

Spring/Summer Block Field students wanting to register for Summer Quarter should find the “generic section” of field and register. The GSSW Registrar will manually adjust credits for those who have completed an exception form.

Foundation Students:

SOWK 4950 CRN 2194 Sec A Foundation Field Intern- BLOCK (5 credits)

Concentration Students

SOWK 4970 CRN 2195 Sec A Concentration Field Intern- BLOCK (6 credits)

Students should not try to find the field section with their liaison name- they should register for the general sections listed above.

Campus Access: Regarding campus access protocols, we have found that some folks who are already vaccinated were confused about expectations for quarantine/symptom tracking and for getting additional COVID tests during the quarter. Others have inadvertently missed the required follow up testing resulting in campus access status being suspended. As a reminder, for the moment for *access to campus for all students and faculty:*

- Even if you have been vaccinated, please continue to use the Everbridge symptom tracking forms [DU Coronavirus Health Wellness Contact Tracing](#)
- Check PioneerWeb on the Home page and click on Campus Access Status to find your next expected 2 COVID test dates and follow the schedule to ensure that you have been cleared.

Reminder to **Winter Quarter Start students**, we expect you will register for summer courses and field credits. If you have not registered for summer, please do so! If you have determined you do not want to take summer classes, check with your academic and field advisors and Victoria.Veres@du.edu to talk about implications for your academic and merit aid plans, since your program plan includes being an active student in summer.

If you are interested in completing a certificate, please check specific certificate application information on the main Course Planning Tools page. Both the **School Social Work and Latinx Certificate application deadlines are May 1, 2021.**

Regarding Summer 2021 registration, find the detailed schedule information on the [GSSW Student Resource Portal Registration Toolkit](#) including a link to the [Online Schedule of Classes](#) which is the most up to date/real time schedule information. For Denver Campus specific information, check out [GSSW Registration Toolkit Denver Registration](#) where a summer 2021 schedule spreadsheet can be found, if you want to see everything we are offering.

If you need a course that we are not offering, you can check the online schedule tool for that course within the MSW@Denver program listings. Please be advised that MSW@Denver summer session starts right away after spring quarter whereas Denver Campus courses are offered in a condensed format over 6 weeks starting in July.

Denver Campus (online and in-person options) between July 12 – August 20

(typically 2 classes per week)

- Concentration Courses Offered: 1-2 courses from each concentration, values course options and both foundation and concentration field. We will also offer some specialized weekend intensive courses, such as in Experiential Therapy, Animal Assisted SW, or Leadership & Supervision—these are “quick” and students find they enjoy the intensive format.
- **All block field placements will run from June 14 – August 20th during summer quarter**

MSW@Denver, fully online program between June 14 – August 20

(typically 1 class per week for 10 weeks)

- All foundation required courses are offered every quarter.
- Concentration Courses Offered: Mental Health and Health & Wellness concentration courses are offered; SOWK 4900 is offered every quarter.
- If you look at the Spring [course schedule](#) with the “Social Work” subject and “DU@2U Distance Program” attribute, you can see the course offerings.
- Students may take up to 10 credits within another graduate program. If you want to take an MSW@Denver course, you must complete the [visiting student application](#) by May 1, 2021.
