Dear GSSW Students,

We write with an update and decision about the GSSW international courses that were tentatively scheduled for Fall Quarter. Given the ongoing impact of the pandemic across the world, and in consultation with our in-country, host community partners, **we have decided to postpone all GSSW international course travel until Spring 2022 Quarter, with anticipated travel in June.** Thus, these three courses will be cancelled for Fall Quarter:

- *SOWK 4757-1: SW & Latinx Cultures (Chiapas, Mexico course)*, CRN: 5122
- *SOWK 4758-1: SW in Kenya*, CRN: 5123
- *SOWK 4763-1: SW & Social Justice: South Africa*, CRN: 5124

It is anticipated that these courses will be offered in Spring Quarter, along with the other international course of *SOWK 4762: Bosnia in Transition: The SW Response*.
