



Information Sheet:

Visiting Student Registration & Course Procedures

Registration outside your 'home' MSW program requires approval by the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs. Please review this documents the complete the [Visiting Student Application](#).

The GSSW Registrar handles the approval and registration process. You will be notified when you have been approved and registered, typically within a week of your request.

Students interested in taking a class through another GSSW MSW program (Denver Campus, Four Corners, Western Colorado, MSW@Denver online) must complete this application by the below deadlines:

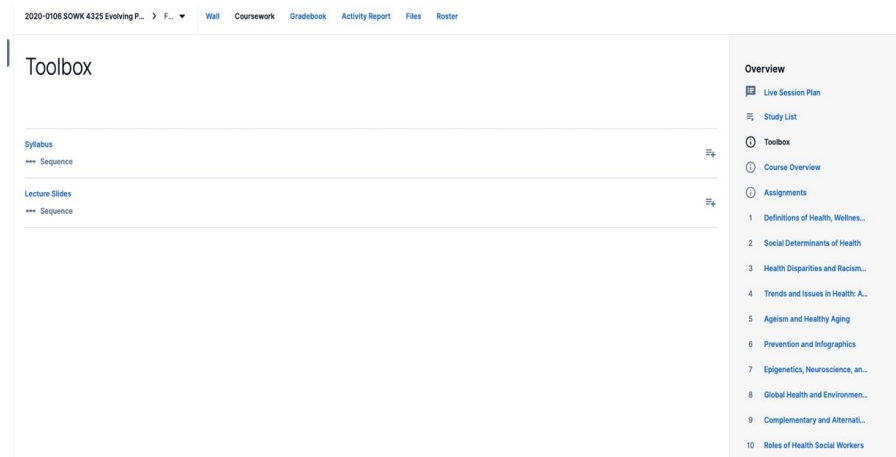
- **Winter Quarter: December 1**
- **Spring Quarter: March 1**
- **Summer Quarter: May 1**
- **Fall Quarter: August 1**

Students who receive permission are subject to available space in the course(s) requested. Receiving permission does not guarantee space in the requested course. Note that students can apply no more than 10 credits outside of their MSW Program to their MSW degree. Tuition is charged at your 'home' tuition rate.

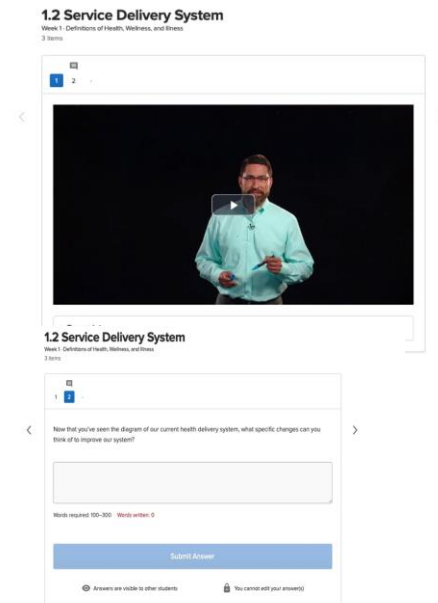
Please remember these key programmatic differences:

- **Denver Campus:** Mostly in-person and a few online classes, mostly Monday - Friday, in weekly 3-hour blocks between 8 am and 9 pm. Class containers use the *Canvas* Learning Management System. Some summer weekend intensive courses are offered.
- **Four Corners in Durango, CO:** Classes in Durango on Fridays and Saturdays for weekly 3-hour blocks. Class containers use the *Canvas* Learning Management System. Summer courses may be offered in alternating years (i.e., 2023, 2025). Foundation and concentration courses run in alternating years, with foundation courses in 2022-2023 and 2024-2025 academic years.
- **Western Colorado in Glenwood Springs, CO:** Classes in Glenwood Springs on Fridays and Saturdays for weekly 3-hour blocks. Class containers use the *Canvas* Learning Management System. Summer courses may be offered in alternating years (i.e., 2022, 2024). Foundation and concentration courses run in alternating years, with foundation courses in 2021-2022 and 2023-2024 academic years.
- **MSW@Denver:** Classes combine prepared asynchronous content with 90 minutes of live videoconference sessions each week, mostly Tuesdays, Wednesdays, & Thursdays evenings and Saturdays. Classes use the 2DU / *.Learn* Learning Management system and require weekly *Zoom* participation for the ten weeks of each quarter. Summer session runs for 10 full weeks, starting June 15, 2020. You can see examples below of what MSW@Denver Classes look like below, and please note you will be required to complete the technology training online before the start of your class.

The *.Learn* Course toolbox provides access to weekly asynchronous work, syllabus, readings, assignments, and other course materials:



During your asynchronous work you will listen to videos from course leads and subject matter experts around the course objectives for that week.



Following the videos, you will often engage discussion questions or quiz questions to enhance understanding and engagement on the topics.

During your weekly Live class sessions (90 minutes) you will participate with your instructor and fellow students via the Zoom classroom (typical classroom sizes are 15-18 students plus your instructor).
