Summary

- The three HAEI-SW certificate courses (3-credits each) must be completed in sequence:
 - SOWK 4795 (HAEI-SW Course 1)
 - SOWK 4796 (HAEI-SW Course 2)
 - SOWK 4797 (HAEI-SW Course 3)
- There is no application process involved to pursue the certificate. You register for the first course (SOWK 4795) to start your certificate studies. Pay close attention to your course planning as the courses must be taken in sequence.



- It is possible to take SOWK 4795 (HAEI-SW Course 1) as a standalone course for interest but it is assumed that you will pursue the certificate when registering for Course 1.
- There is no requirement for a specialized field placement related to the certificate.
