Mount Saint Vincent Home Outpatient Program

Mount Saint Vincent serves youth ages 2 to 18, and their families. Interns will gain experience in treatment of trauma, mental health issues, social-emotional and behavioral issues. This is a clinical focused internship, and students will have the opportunity to participate in individual therapy, family therapy, group therapy and case management.



Ability Connection Colorado

Ability Connection Colorado facilitates individual development of children through family support and a nurturing educational environment. Interns will manage and deliver services to children and families to reduce social-emotional concerns in the classroom and increase positive parenting practices and skills. Interns will help reinforce the importance of positive parent and child interactions for the healthy growth and development of the child, and for ongoing family development. Interns will gain skills in

using intervention, prevention, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy and more in addressing challenging behavior and creating solutions.



University of Denver Student Success Coaching

Interns will work as Student Success Coaches meeting with undergraduate students to help improve and maximize their college experience. Coaches will use customizable curriculum to help students learn skills in goal setting, time management & organization, study skills and more. Coaches empower students to achieve a sustainable shift in thinking and behavior, leading to increased motivation, accomplishment of goals, and academic success. Interns will also have the opportunity to participate in resource development, research, and leadership workshops.

Eligible students may also use their internship activities as a DU Work Study site at a rate of \$18/hour.
