### Maria Droste Counseling Center – Internship Program

Interns may provide counseling to different populations: adults and families at Maris Droste, children in Elementary, Middle, or High schools, or co-located with a community partner such as a senior living facility and a sexual violence and abuse support agency. Interns will regularly meet with clients, bill for sessions, and complete comprehensive education under individual supervision by clinical staff and private practitioners. This internship provides invaluable preparation for post-graduation/licensure entry to the mental health field.

### Family Tree Community Family Resource Team

Interns assist with cases referred to the Community Family Resource Team (CFRT) program by Jefferson and Adams' county DHS workers. Interns will work with therapists to provide weekly trauma-informed individual and family therapy focused on improving family functioning and acting as a protective factor against escalating involvement by DHS. Interns will have the ability to manage basic psychotherapy

cases, as well as provide more intensive therapy under the supervision of a task supervisor. CFRT provides in-home services and requires interns to have reliable transportation (mileage may be reimbursed). Interns can work from home when not providing direct services after training.

## **VitalCare**

VitalCare offers clinical therapy and social work services to clients in an outpatient setting, striving to provide an environment like private practice. Interns will have the opportunity to serve clients under clinical supervision via individual, group, and family therapy. Interns will coordinate client care and research available resources needed by clients and families.
