University of Colorado Denver- Addiction Research and Treatment Services (ARTS) - Specialized Outpatient Services

Addiction Research and Treatment Services (ARTS) is the clinical program that provides residential and outpatient substance abuse treatment services in Colorado, psychosocial and pharmacological treatments for adolescents, women, men, families, and those involved in the criminal justice system.

Interns will do intake assessments, individual counseling, group counseling, couples /family counseling, in-service trainings, Difficult Case Reviews, treatment planning, case management.

This is a paid internship and may be CLIMB-OWEP stipend eligible and is approved for Extended Field Learning.



Boulder Medical Center

Interns will work alongside the Patient Advocate (LPC), Quality Care Manager (LCSW) and Psych Nurse (RN) to handle a range of behavioral health issues that may arise for patients (of all ages, as this is a primary care office) when seeking medical care for prevention or a physical ailment. Interns will conduct brief interventions and carry a caseload with a mix of short-term and more long-term patients who may have chronic medical conditions with associated behavioral health symptoms, of patients exhibiting

resistance to following through with medical treatment and/or of patients who are experiencing stress, anxiety, depression, grief.

This internship may be CLIMB@DU stipend eligible.



Boulder Housing Partners

Boulder Housing Partners-Resident Services own and manage affordable housing for low and moderate income residents. Interns gain practical experience in assisting residents to thrive in complex and changing social and economic situations.

Opportunities also include work at the senior sites of Boulder Housing Partners to assist elders to successfully age in place by assisting them with resources and quality of life programming.

This is a paid internship and may be work study eligible.
