Center for Valued Living is a mental health clinic/private practice with many clinicians that assist clients in their journey towards self-discovery, personal growth, self-acceptance, acceptance of others, the ability to recognize and make valued choices and facilitate the development of a multitude of skills. Interns will provide mental health services for children, adolescents, and families.



Humane Society of the United States- Prairie Dog Conflict Resolution Team

The Prairie Dog Coalition is an alliance of non-profit organizations, concerned citizens, and scientists dedicated to the protection of imperiled prairie dogs and restoration of their ecosystems. Interns will be assisting in various projects that include outreach, community assessments, humane education, wildlife policy, and conservation projects. Interns also have the opportunity to learn about the social structures that are impacting wildlife and learn about what organizations are doing to advocate for imperiled species. This internship ideally starts in August and continues through May.

Kent Denver School

Kent Denver is a private, coeducational college-preparatory school serving middle and high school students in grades 6-12. Interns reach out and meet with students, individually, to provide brief therapy and crisis management.
