### Denver Public Schools- Department of Social Work and Psychological Services

Interns in a direct school placement doing general school social work will be engaged in learning about special education laws, policies, and programs, intervention and involvement with Social /Emotional assessments (interviews, formal assessments and reports), and Crisis Response: Learning child abuse reporting procedures and how to facilitate threat assessments and suicide risk reports
