As a lower legislative chamber for the state of Colorado, this is a great internship opportunity for students interested in macro legislative positions.

Interns will be assigned a range of tasks as needed, primarily but not limited to: drafting fact sheets on bills passing through committees, processing constituent responses, attending lunch events hosted by organizations bringing their concerns to the Capitol, composing research memos on draft legislation, and data entry. Porchlight: A Family Justice Center

PorchLight: A Family Justice Center provides comprehensive legal, emotional, and critical supportive services for survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, abuse of at-risk individuals, elder

abuse, and human trafficking. serve survivors, victims and their children experiencing trauma for any reason with a specific focus on issues regarding domestic violence, human trafficking, child abuse, elder abuse, sex abuse and abuse and neglect of at-risk individuals. Our services are free and voluntary, and we do not screen for income, legal status, residency, or address.

Intern would work with the navigation department providing case management services to guests coming into the justice center for services and connect them to the appropriate community partners/resources in the building; participate in high risk case reviews; be on phones to facilitate crisis calls and client referrals; attend staff meetings; and have an opportunity to shadow all of the community partners in the building (could include court watching, ride a long with law enforcement, touring jails, etc.).



Phoenix Center at Auraria

The Phoenix Center at Auraria | Anschutz (PCA) addresses interpersonal violence on college and professional education campuses. The Phoenix Center provides free and confidential assistance and advocacy to individuals dealing with issues of interpersonal violence including sexual violence, relationship violence, and stalking.

This is an exciting opportunity for an MSW intern to be involved in the development of resources and client services in the area of interpersonal violence. Interns will get experience working on the 24/7 helpline, providing crisis intervention, working one on one with clients, attending protection order hearings at court, providing educational presentations/workshops to the campus and training staff, students, and faculty on IPV.

***Since this internship is on a college campus that runs on the semester system, the internships begin in early August and end in late May.**
