Ally Financial Public Policy Scholars Program

The Ally Financial Public Policy Scholars Program awards up to \$10,000 to academically talented and highly motivated African-American or Black undergraduate sophomore or junior pursuing a degree in policy to include, but not limited to, political science, public policy analysis and public administration. Candidates must be US Citizens or permanent residents, a full-time undergraduate sophomore or junior at an accredited college or university, demonstrate a commitment to policy, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, exhibit leadership, and be active in community, and be qualified African-American or black students.

This opportunity awards academically talented and highly motivated African-American or Black undergraduate sophomore or junior pursuing a degree in Public Policy to include, but not limited to, political science, public policy analysis and public administration.

Candidate Requirements

- Be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident
- Be a full-time undergraduate sophomore or junior at an accredited college or university
- Demonstrate a commitment to public policy
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale
- Exhibit leadership and be active in community
- Selected applicants will be qualified African-American or black students **Application Materials**
- Completed 2-part online application must be submitted by 11:59 pm on the deadline date.
- Personal Statement Response
- Video Essay Response (not to exceed 5 minutes)
- 2 Letter of Recommendations
- Transcript(s) must be uploaded directly in Academic Works (application portal)
- Resume listing work experience, extracurricular activities, honors, community service and special skills

The Clean Cities University Workforce Development Program is an initiative of Clean Cities, a government-industry partnership sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy's Vehicle Technologies Program. Clean Cities strives to reduce petroleum consumption in the transportation sector in nearly 100 communities across the country. Since the creation of the CCUWDP in 2010, Clean Cities has hosted more than 500 interns in more than 75 Coalitions. The Clean Cities internship will give students studying communications, public relations, business, marketing, engineering or environmental sciences, the opportunity to grow public awareness and expand the markets of advanced vehicle technologies, alternative fuels, and practices that reduce the consumption of petroleum. Students have participated in research, outreach activities, public education, K-12 outreach, fleet events, and a vast array of transportation-related environmental projects.

Microsoft Cybersecurity Scholarship Program

- The Last Mile Education Fund and Microsoft are working together to address the diversity and talent shortages in the cybersecurity workforce by investing in students like you.
- The Microsoft Cybersecurity Scholarship Program supports community college degree and industry certificate completion through financial assistance (up to \$500) and subsidies for cybersecurity certification exam costs (up to \$375). Financial assistance is intended to cover short-term basic needs, such as food, rent, health-related, transportation/car issues, and/or a laptop/device.

Eligibility:

- Residents of the United States
- Students currently enrolled in a cybersecurity-related program at a twoyear institution in the United States, such as a community college or technical school
- Students who are able to demonstrate financial need by providing Pell Grant eligibility, financial aid award letters, or other evidence of need All students with financial need are eligible to apply. Students from groups who are underrepresented in cybersecurity are especially encouraged to apply, including those who identify as women, non-binary, and/or Black/LatinX/Indigenous, veterans, and/or have a disability.
