#### **Children's Trauma Center**

The Children's Trauma Center (CTC) provides comprehensive trauma treatment for children ages 3-19.

CTC has 1 opening for an intern interested in strengthening the parent/caretaker and child relationship, promoting whole health for each child and family member, collaborating with child connected community partners. The intern will be responsible for overseeing whole health therapeutic activities, whole health assessments, activities that promote social connection, outdoor therapeutic activities, client resource referrals, school advocacy and coordination, team teaching and presentations, and administrative duties.

This internship offers a paid internship or is DU work study eligible.



**Denver Family Institute** 

Denver Family Institute (DFI) is a private, nonprofit organization open to all and dedicated to providing quality marriage and family therapy training, consultation to community agencies, and therapy to individuals, couples, and families. DFI has 4 openings in two clinics that involve working with a wide range of clients in different settings ranging from a homeless shelter to a general practice clinic.

Interns are trained and supervised in clinical work with individuals, couples and families from a strength based, solution focused systems perspective. Interns will participate in intakes, admin. support, grant writing, and enhance clinical skills through the use of video and live supervision via one-way mirrors.

Grace in Balance provides at-risk youth with counseling, trauma-informed, and mindfulness-based yoga classes in order to promote healing, resilience, self-development, and positive social change.

Grace in Balance has 1 opening for an intern interested in working with school-aged clients whose social-emotional difficulties interfere with his/her capacity to function adequately as a student. The intern will conduct and complete non-stigmatizing psychosocial assessment to evaluate the needs of adolescents, and/or school-aged children for mental health and support services, serve as a liaison between schools and community agencies, Provide early interventions and referrals to specialty mental health services and provide clinical interventions.
