Focus Points Family Resource Center is a nonprofit organization that serve diverse families, majority of whom are low-income, Latinx immigrants. This is a great opportunity for students who are interested in learning more about case management and/or mezzo social work careers.

Interns receive professional training and will provide direct services, resources, and support for families to meet their goals.

Focus point Family Resource Center primarily serve Spanish speaking families and are interested in students who are bilingual in Spanish and English.



Lifelong Inc.

Lifelong Inc provide specialized, creative, and structured services for each client to support their learning, mental health, and family preservation goals as appropriately aligned with their disabilities while addressing barriers attached to these difficulties.

Lifelong Inc has 6 internship openings for students interested in an autonomous internship. Interns may be able to supervise visitation between parents and children, transport children to visits with their parents, practice therapeutic tools to address mental health support in the moment, writing case notes, attend staff meetings, IEP's, and trainings and provide mentorship to youth.
