Panelists will discuss the recently published, co-edited volume *Poetics & Praxis 'After' Objectivism* and the path forward for documentary poetry and social activism.

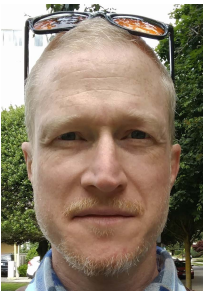
