Mentors play a key role in shaping the next generation of teachers. The Teacher Education Program at DU has one fundamental goal: increasing achievement for all students. We enact this mission by training highly effective teachers, but we can't do it without you.

The Teacher Education Program Offers Mentor Teachers:

- Apprentice Teacher
 - Support for small group or individual student work
 - Collaborator in planning and data analysis
 - Shared teaching responsibilities
- \$300 stipend for August-June placement
 - $\circ~$ Stipend is \$150 in the event of a 1 semester placement
- Training and support
 - Online modules for training in coaching, observation, and feedback
 - Collaboration with University Supervisors to guide Apprentice development

DU Mentor Teachers Agree To:

- Meet with University Supervisor 2-3 times through the year
- Meet and plan regularly with Apprentice Teacher
- Provide feedback on Apprentice teaching performance
