Dear Continuing Denver Campus Foundation Students;

Thank you for completing the survey and for your patience in waiting for our response. We understand that winter quarter registration is more complex than usual and that you may be confused and have questions.

Please do not worry. We have received your surveys and ask that you give the Registrar's Office and Academic Affairs some time to process the information.

We are noticing more students moving into the online format for winter and need to make some adjustments to the schedule. As a result, our goal to have everyone registered by November 18, 2020 is not feasible. Over the next several days, we will be looking at your elected options and adjusting the on campus and online offerings accordingly. This also requires some conversations with instructors. Once we get our schedule set, we will move forward with registration.

If additional action is needed on your part, detailed instructions will be provided at that time.

At the moment, foundation students are only to register for their Field section of SOWK 4950 (by liaison name). If you are not planning on field for winter quarter, you do not need to register at this time.

If you still have questions and need to connect, please refer to the [GSSW Student Resource Portal Contact Us](#) page. While email is an option, please remember there are other ways to connect including office hours open to anyone without an appointment.

We recognize the uncertainty of this time is uncomfortable and that we are all looking for some type of security or sense of control over our lives. Indeed, at the least, it would be nice to know what the winter quarter will hold. We are aware that this is the end of the fall quarter and that in addition to registration questions you are facing a lot of pressure in your academic and personal lives. The strain is real and we are all doing our best.

We also recognize that with classes starting in January, we have some time to get this right. This is an emerging process and requires some resilience to manage. Our aim is to support your requests to the best of our ability and to keep everyone's health and safety at the forefront of our planning. Thank you for working with us and for your patience at this time.
