Eligibility:

- (A) In lieu of conference attendance, students may apply for up to \$500 in dissertation/DRP/DIP funding but may not exceed the \$1000 allotment in student reimbursements for the fiscal year. Students may apply for dissertation/DRP/DIP funding only once during their program.
- (B) Students who have successfully defended their dissertation/DRP/DIP proposal may apply for funding support for their dissertation/DRP/DIP up to the amount of \$500. The amount of funding available is subject to annual budget limitations.
- (C) Students are eligible for grants only after the dissertation/DRP/DIP proposal has been accepted.
- (D) Students must obtain advisor signature stating that this research is ***not fully funded*** by any other resource.
- (E) Students must be a current student to apply for dissertation/DRP/DIP funding. All applications received after the requesting student has graduated, withdrawn, or was dismissed from MCE will be denied.
- (F) Attach three to four pages (double-spaced, 12 font size, 1-inch margins) addressing the following criteria:
 1. A description of the need for the study or statement of the problem.
 2. A description of the research questions, hypotheses, or the objectives.
 3. Methods and the analytic approach.
 4. The significance or expected scholarly outcomes of the project.
 5. The form and outlets for presentation of the findings after successfully completing the dissertation/DRP/DIP.
- (G) Attach a one-page budget, developed in consultation with your dissertation chair. If your budget includes gift cards for research with human subjects, please consult your dissertation chair and IRB for guidelines regarding reporting the use of gift cards.
