- Provide evidence from your primary and secondary works. Use either MLA or Chicago format for your citations in either a list of works cited, or in notes.
- Two-page proposal and/or outline due on Friday, February 12.
- Your presentation may engage with your research project in-progress.

Project length (grads.): 15-20 pages (or the equivalent, depending upon media)
