Craig Woody is the Vice Chancellor for Business and Financial Affairs and Treasurer of the University of Denver. He is responsible for Accounting and Financial Reporting; Cash, Student Accounts, Endowment and Long-Term Debt Management; University Architect and Facilities Management; Campus Safety; Enterprise Risk Management; Environmental Health and Safety; Procurement; and various auxiliary operations and contractual services.

He was involved with the design and implementation of the university's resource management system in the early 1990's; participated in the design and construction of \$643 million of new building and renovation projects in recent years. He also serves as the chair of the Research Universities Council of the National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO) and a joint working group of CIO's and CFO's on administrative systems for NACUBO/EDUCAUSE.

Prior to joining the University in 1984, Mr. Woody worked in the audit department of KPMG.
