

Simon Lomax is a Denver-based adviser to Divestment Facts, a program of the Independent Petroleum Association of America. He also serves as a managing director with FTI Consulting, a global business advisory firm.

Before going into advocacy, Mr. Lomax spent 15 years working in journalism and government, and most of his career was devoted to covering energy and environmental policy from Washington, D.C. He was the editorial director for a national TV show on environmental issues, an energy reporter at Bloomberg News and a senior editor at Argus Media Inc., a leading provider of news, analysis and market data for the energy industry.

During his time as a news reporter, Mr. Lomax took a break from journalism to work in the U.S. House of Representatives as a congressional fellow with the American Political Science Association. He worked in the office of former U.S. Rep. Wayne Gilchrest (R-MD) on energy and climate legislation. More recently, Mr. Lomax has testified to Congress about the research, media and campaign tactics of anti-energy groups, including their efforts to undermine the scientific peer-review process.

Prior to his work in Washington, Mr. Lomax worked in metropolitan and small-town newspapers in Australia and in Mississippi. He has a B.A. in Journalism from the Queensland University of Technology in Brisbane, Australia.
