David Miller was the President and CEO of The Denver Foundation from 1996 until 2016. The Denver Foundation is the oldest and largest community foundation in the Rocky Mountain region. Under David's leadership, the assets of The Denver Foundation grew from \$58 million to well over \$700 million and generous donors contributed more than \$1 billion to The Denver Foundation as a vehicle for their charitable giving.

In March 2016, David joined the University of Denver, where he is Executive Director of a new Institute for Philanthropy and Social Enterprise.

David is a native of Denver and a fifth generation Denverite. He is a graduate of Thomas Jefferson High School in Denver, Harvard College, and Harvard Law School. Since then, he has worked in all three sectors: public, private, and nonprofit.

David spent ten years in Colorado state and local government, serving as Executive Director of the Colorado Office of State Planning and Budgeting under Governor Richard Lamm and Chief of Staff for Denver Mayor Federico Peña. After that and before coming to The Denver Foundation, he was a principal in Greenberg, Baron, Simon & Miller (GBSM), a strategic communications consulting firm.

David is married to Lisa Farber Miller. They have two children and three grandchildren.
