Research Projects: Options & Guidelines

Individual Projects (Shakespeare's Hamlet):

- Memorize and recite a passage, or
- Write an adaption of a scene or part of a scene, or
- Create an artifact or prop from the play, or
- Study the significance of key words in the play, or
- Other ideas?

Group Projects (Hamlet on film and in popular culture):

- Write a screenplay for two or more scenes, or
- Create a short film, or
- Write a collaborative research paper (10-15 pages), or
- Document a popular culture creative / research workshop, or
- Other ideas?
