The Main Library is located in the **Anderson Academic Commons (AAC)**. The AAC is home to the university's extensive library collections. It also has 32 technologically-equipped small and large group study rooms, space for quiet and individual study, and brings together services points such as the Research Center, the Writing Center, and the Digital Media Center.

### RESOURCES

The University Libraries contain millions of research resources, many of which are available electronically from the library's web page: <http://library.du.edu>. Search for scholarly articles and books using **Compass** on the library's homepage. You can also locate databases by subject or alphabetically under **Databases**; or start your research with our librarians' **Research Guides**.

### RESEARCH HELP

The Research Center is available to help you find the resources you need for your papers and class projects, whether that be books, articles, statistics, or images! ### BORROWING

Use your DU ID to check out materials. Books and other materials are stored at both the AAC and offsite at the Hampden Center. You can access materials stored at the AAC by yourself, or you can use the book paging service available via the **Request It** button in Compass to have materials retrieved from the AAC or the Hampden Center for you and delivered to the Lending Desk.

### WORKSHOPS

The AAC offers a number of workshops for students on finding books and articles, using **Google** and **Google Scholar** for research, creating works cited pages easily with **RefWorks**, and more. Workshops are advertised on the library's home page at the beginning of every quarter and at <http://libguides.du.edu/libraryinstruction>.

### PRINTING AND PHOTOCOPYING

The AAC has printers, scanners, and a copier for your use!

**TO PRINT**—use your DU ID to pay, students are allotted \$21/quarter for printing.

**TO COPY**—use your flex account and DU ID to pay. 10 cents/copy.

**TO SCAN**—it's free to make a digital copy!
