Before the <u>first day</u> of classes:

- Subscribe to your program email list serve.

Before the end of Fall quarter:

- Make an appointment to meet with your advisor to complete an approved coursework plan. These need to be typed, signed by both student and advisor, and submitted to your program's Academic Services Associate (ASA). The coursework plan is updated every year.
- If you plan to request that credit from another institution be transferred to your current program, complete a <u>Transfer of Credit form</u> while meeting with your advisor. Signed forms should be submitted to your program's ASA.
