





Great news - the University of Denver has given all students access to the DU Career Network!

What is the DU Career Network?

It is an online platform that connects you with a powerful network of DU alumni who have volunteered to offer one-on-one advice on career topics like job and internship search, networking, salary negotiation and more. You can also connect with alumni who work in your target organizations.

Steps to getting started:

- 1. Activate your account by setting up a profile. <u>Activate here</u>.
- 2. Join any applicable groups to connect easily with alumni with similar backgrounds and interests.
- 3. Get matched with, or search freely for, University of Denver mentors who can help you get to where you want to go.
- 4. Connect by phone, video or chat.
