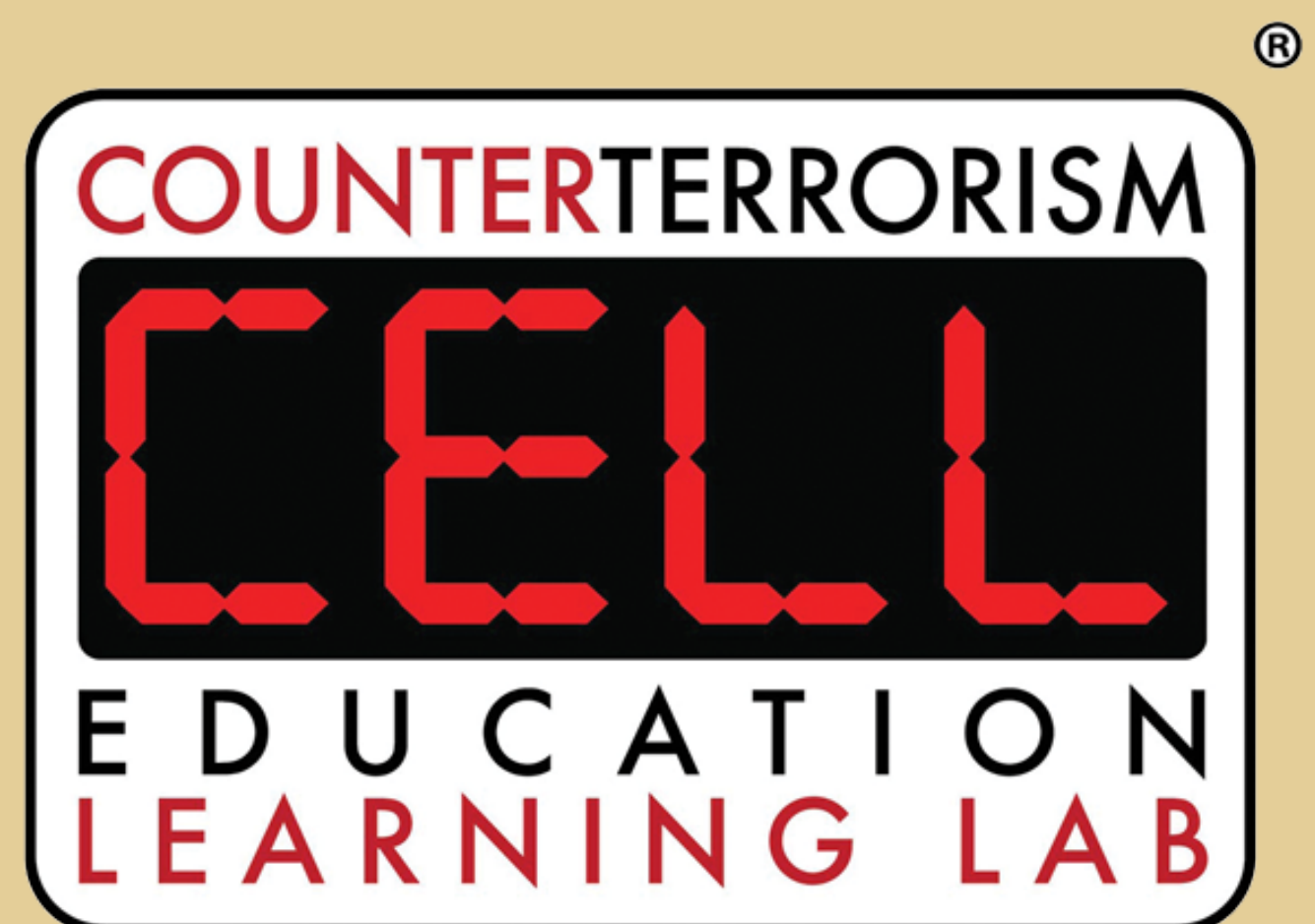


## Common Threads: Colorado's Intelligence Committee

## Honors FBI Internship

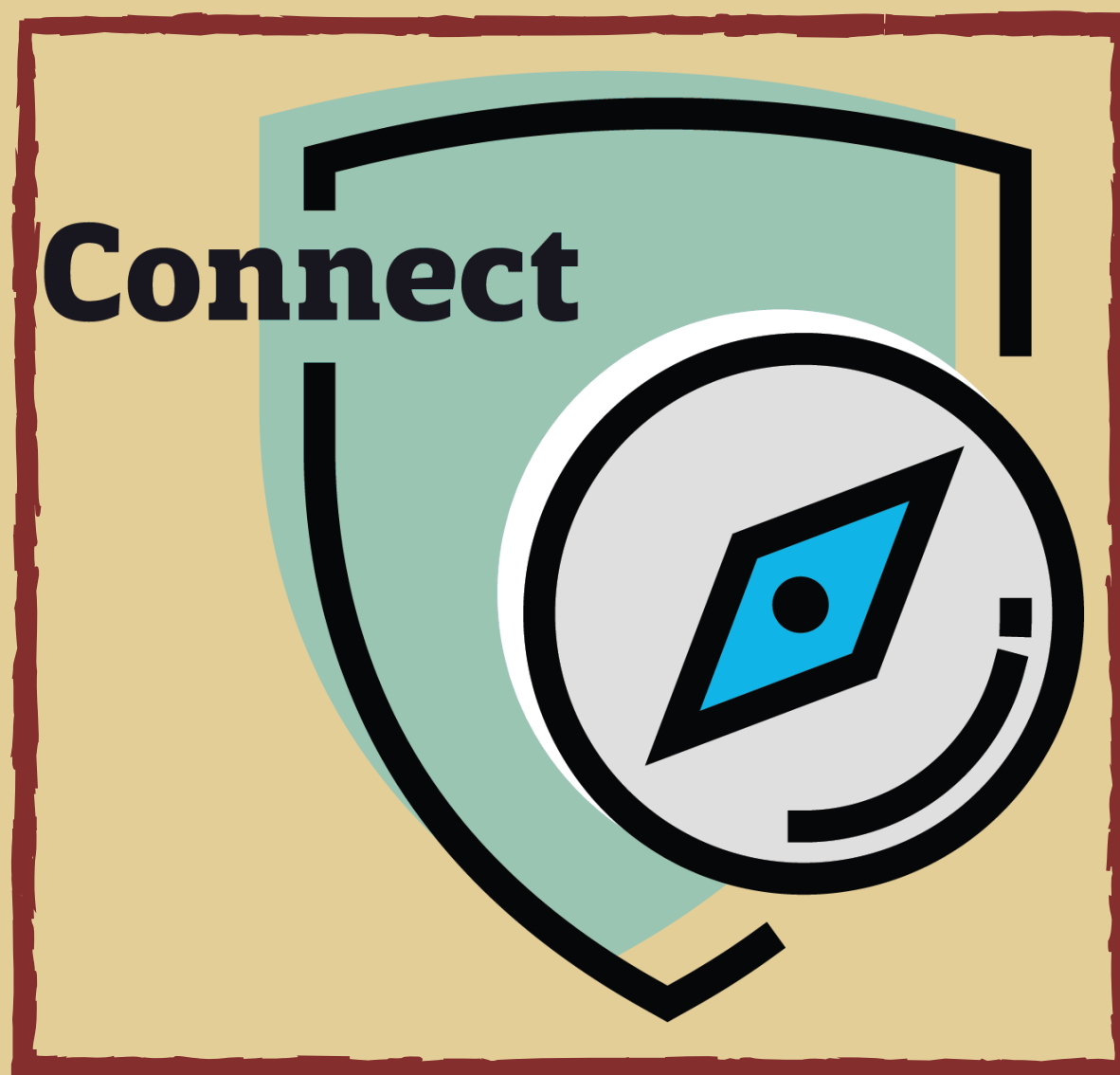
