 - 1. A grant up to 75% or \$300 (presenters) or \$250 (attendees), whichever is less.
 - a. This increased funding is applicable for Spring 2021.
 - 2. This is your Graduate Student Association (GSA).
 - 3. For Spring 2021, funding eligibility runs from 2/22-5/21
 - 4. Application Process
 - a. Common Application

 - c. All original receipts
 - d. Copy of presentation listing in program/ Proof of Merit
