- This is an opportunity for each site's representative to collaborate with other sites in the design of a robust set of lifelong learning opportunities for our current and future OLLI members.
- It is anticipated that the members of this committee will bring ideas from the work of their site's Curriculum Committee.
- This group will choose a chair or co-chairs who will lead the work in collaboration with the Executive Director and proposed Curriculum Manager (see below).
- Initially Jackie will oversee the work of the Core Curriculum Committee; however, I have submitted a request to DU to establish a new OLLI at DU positiona Curriculum Manager. This request is pending approval.
- The chair(s) of this committee will provide reports for the OLLI management team and the Strategic Planning and Executive Advisory Committees
- The work of the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusivity Committee should be incorporated into the work of the Core Curriculum Committee.
- Revision of the current Curriculum Committee handbook (latest version was updated in 2013)

TWO COMPONENTS TO THE OLLI ON THE MOVE INITIATIVE

- 1. Promotional -- to introduce people to the OLLI program
 - a. One-time presentations with an OLLI "activity" and time for an OLLI informational session
 - b. Four-week, 90-minute courses to public libraries where meeting location and marketing are covered by the organization and courses are free to people who sign up (Facilitators would be from a cadre of volunteer facilitators.
- 2. **Programmatic** -- to bring OLLI courses to select communities (AND introduce them to OLLI)
 - a. Delivery of four- week, 90-minute courses OR a four-week sampler of four courses facilitated by a cadre of volunteers. Class members would register with OLLI as Introductory Members with the option to upgrade to a full term membership.
 - b. Provide access to OLLI webinar series at offsite locations with an on-site, volunteer discussion leader.
