- ◆ The \$130 cost per term entitles you to take as many courses as you like at any of six Denver Metro area locations (Boulder, East, Central, West, South, and the DU Campus)
- ◆ Courses cover academic subjects in history, literature, music, philosophy, film, current events, technology, science, writing, social issues, and more. A speaker series, field trips, and workshops expand the curriculum.
