TRAVEL TIPS: Useful Career Resources

Social Media Clean Up

Hopefully winter break will provide you with a few relax and recharge moments. During this time, you may find little pockets of time to get ready for the buzz of the upcoming quarters. This is a great time to check in on your social media, to make sure that they are ready for employer eyes! 45% of employers admit that they look at social media platforms to research candidates. So, while your polished and pristine resume may be ready, it is critical that your social media presence tells the same story!

- Type your name in a general search engine and see what pulls up!
- Consider setting all personal social media sites to private settings. Leave your LinkedIn profile accessible (the chance to be called for an interview increases by 71% if you have a custom URL LinkedIn address on a resume header of a comprehensive profile).
- Deactivate any old account that you are not currently using.
- Hide and delete any inappropriate photos or posts. While this information doesn't go away completely, make it harder for an employer to access it!
- Know your public record! Double check your public record to make sure that you are aware of any information that would be easy for an employer to see - greet that information head-on and don't try to run from it!
- Edit your handles, email address and URLs to an intentional, professional image.
- Begin sharing & posting industry related news, quotes or articles. Don't just state that you are aware of current trends, show it!
- Update profile photos and bios with a professional touch.
- Begin to follow companies, industry professionals and associations, so that your feed displays an individual with a strong professional network.

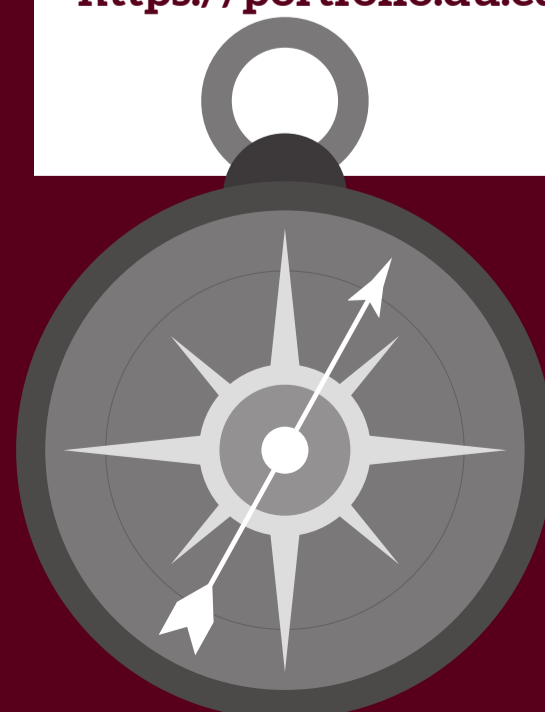

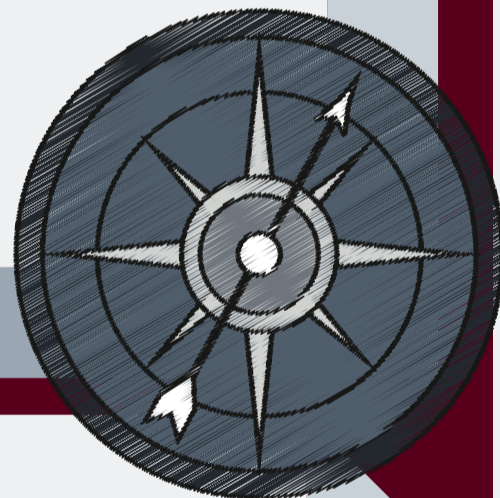
