TRAVEL TIPS: Useful Career Resources

Fair Season is upon Us! Are You Ready?

Whether you are beginning to look for post-grad employment or your next field placement, Field & Career Fairs can be an important networking piece of your strategy. To some, the anxious activity of a fair setting can be overwhelming. Here are some tips to help you navigate a career fair, so that YOU stand out to an employer:

Research. Almost all fairs will provide a list of agencies prior to the fair. Explore online information to determine if the agency has a value alignment. Employees with the highest satisfaction are those where their skill set, and interests align with the agency position and need.

Get organized - use your time wisely. Once you've researched the agencies that will be at the fair, make note of the top 10 that you want to make a point to meet. Write down questions you have about the agency/position, so that you don't forget to ask them if you get nervous.

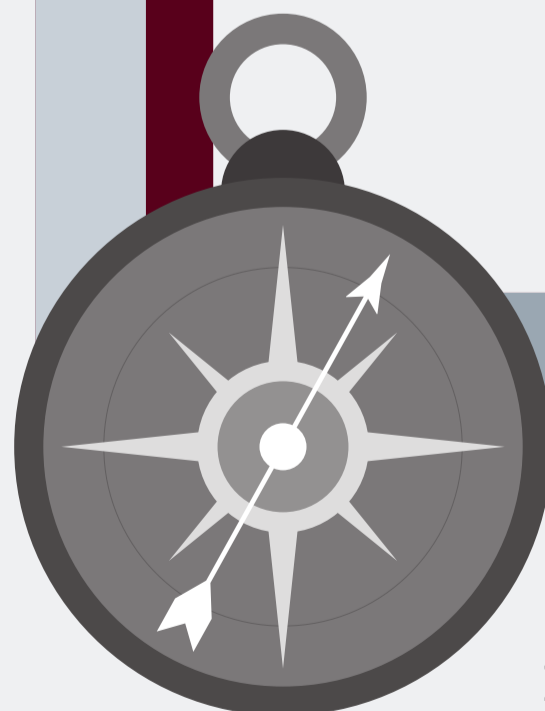
Career fairs can feel informal, so many do not take the step to dress for the job. An easy way to stand out is to think of the fair as a screening interview - your first opportunity to impress, and dress professionally.

Finally, give yourself the professional edge: formal communication and follow-through during the process, well-articulated elevator pitch (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wYwZ_1VW1gY&feature=youtu.be) to showcase your skills, and tailored resumes.

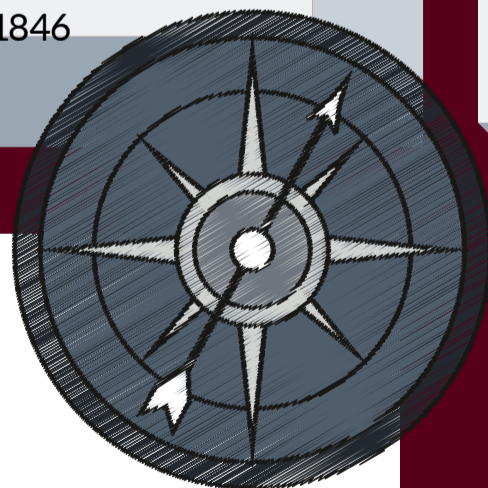
