TRAVEL TIPS: Useful Career Resources

Networking Your Way through Break

In a world of uncertainty, one thing is certain. If you are graduating in 2021, family and friends will begin to ask, repeatedly, what your plans are after graduation! While this is often anxiety producing, preparing for these conversations will not only assist you in surviving them, but affords an opportunity to lean into your network. During the semester break, students traditionally attend holiday events or family/friend get togethers. This year the landscape will look very different. Some events may flip to virtual formats and others will simply be cancelled. Don't let that stop you from using this time to network.

Determine a virtual networking plan.

- Your network: Who haven't you spoken to in a while? Today's virtual world has led to natural & genuine reasons for people to reach out and "check in" with each other. Reaching out now will set the tone for further outreach as you near graduation.
- Attend virtual networking events. Research and plan out events you want to attend. Networking events this time of year tend to be light-hearted and informal, so it's a great place to practice networking!
- Look to expand your network. It's normal to reach out to those that know you well and will affirm you, but who can they introduce you to? Who do you know that might benefit them? Who could you virtual brainstorm with to expand your network?
- Online research. Use resources like Pioneer Careers Online, professional organizations, LinkedIn or simple google search engines to locate agencies and contacts that you'd like to connect with between now and graduation. Start reaching out with a simple LinkedIn message or email.

Finally, practice your nonverbal cues & know your strategy. If a close family or friend senses that you are unsure, they may attempt to "swarm in to help!" This often can produce more anxiety and loss of self-control, none of which will help you spring board into your final quarters. Remember, self-isolating doesn't have to mean social isolation!

The Cognitive Behavioral Intervention for Trauma in Schools (CBITS)

program is a school-based, group and individual intervention. CBITS uses cognitive-behavioral techniques (e.g., psychoeducation, relaxation, social problem solving, cognitive restructuring, and exposure).

CDE is offering this FREE virtual CBITS training for school teams (minimum of two people) per team. This training is an all-day virtual training (8:30am - 3:30pm) with 5 hours of pre-homework that is required in order to participate. Each date is limited to 15 people maximum. Participants will receive 5 hours of CE credit from the CBITS pretraining and 6.5 CDE clock hours for participating in the training.

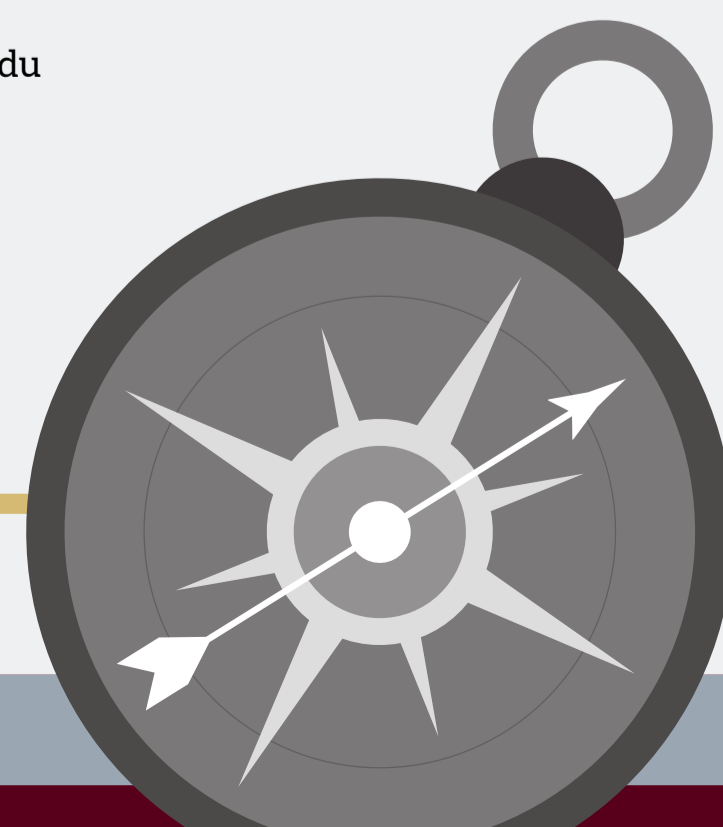

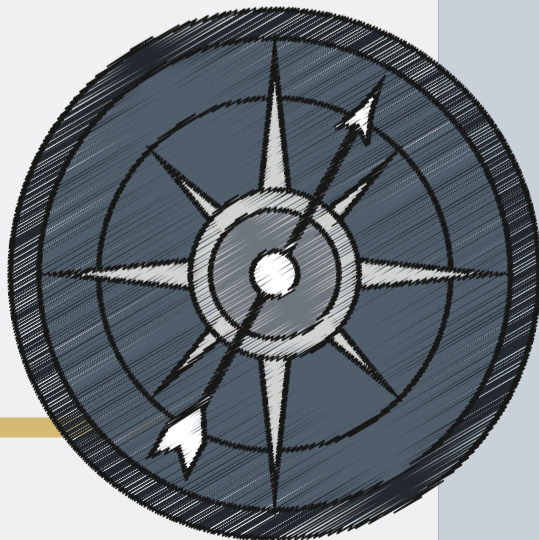
