

Registration

Students registering for the first time will receive their registration instructions from the Office of Graduate Studies one to two months before classes start. The IIC Student Services Coordinator will also inform new students when they will be able to register during the summer before Autumn Quarter.

Make sure to keep the Office of Graduate Studies and the IIC Student Services Coordinator updated on your current email, phone number, and mailing address, including if you have just moved to Denver. You can update your contact information on PioneerWeb. Please also email the IIC Student Services Coordinator at iic@du.edu.

In all subsequent quarters, registration instructions will be available online at <http://www.du.edu/registrar/registration/howtoregister.html>. Every Autumn Quarter, students should meet with their general adviser and draw up a course plan (see Advising section). All registration is done online and is easily accessible through <https://myweb.du.edu>. NOTE: Be sure to consult the registration and billing calendar on the Registrar's website at <http://www.du.edu/registrar/calendar/index.html> to avoid late registration fees. Students may drop and add courses during the first week of classes with no penalty.
