Every semester WOLA's new interns are paired with staff mentors and integrated into the work of the organization. Interns also participate in the behind-the-scenes work of running a non-profit organization, including helping with technology, media, finance, and event planning.

Low-income children in Colorado do not receive the same quality of education as their more affluent peers. While Colorado has the third highest percentage of adults with college degrees, our state ranks at the very bottom for high school graduates continuing to college.

Since our founding in 2007, Teach For America - Colorado has significantly increased our impact within the state's highest need schools. We now operate in school districts and charter schools in the Denver Metro, Colorado Springs and Pueblo areas. There are more than 650 new and experienced TFA teachers directly impacting over 35,000 students who are primarily Latino Hispanic and African American.
