Meetings

SASP Student Board Positions & Duties

Administrative Committee (Co-chairs)

President: Responsible for planning and overseeing monthly board meetings, delegating tasks and checking in on all committees, attending board related events and activities.

Treasurer: Responsible for tracking the quarterly budget, submitting reimbursement paperwork to the college, periodically reminding board members of the group's financial standing, attending and contributing to monthly board meetings, attending board related events and activities.

First Year Representative: Responsible for heading up communication between the board and the first year cohort, attending and contributing to monthly board meetings, attending board related events and activities.

Pathways Representative: Responsible for heading up communication between the board and the PhD Pathways program, attending and contributing to monthly board meetings, attending board related events and activities.

National Association of School Psychologists Representatives (2): Points of contact between the national level association and the program, plan School Psychology Awareness Week activities and promotions, plan the social networking event at the annual NASP meeting, attending and contributing to monthly board meetings, attending board related events and activities.

Program Committee (Co-chairs)

Vice President: Responsible for attending department faculty meetings, bringing programmatic questions and concerns to and from faculty, attending and contributing to monthly board meetings, attending board related events and activities.
